

Facility Visitation Plan

- Visitors must provide a negative Covid test from the last 7 days in order to visit our facility.
- Visiting hours will be available, by appointment only, via facility website www.littlenecknursing.com/visitor-info/
- Visitation between our residents and their loved ones will be conducted inside the main dining room.
- Main Dining room is limited to a maximum of 10 people at a time (includes residents and visitors)
- 1 visitor allowed per resident
- Visits will be under the supervision of a staff member who will accompany the resident outside.
- Visits will be arranged for 30 minutes. Visits will be arranged by facility and monitored by staff.
- There will be no touching of residents permitted.
- All visitors must wear a mask at all times, must have their temperature taken upon arrival at the reception desk. Visitors must respond appropriately to the Covid-19 questions asked and supply information for entry into the kiosk maintained at the reception desk.
- If they fail to meet the criteria, they will not be able to visit at that time. If they do not follow the rules established for visitation, they will not be permitted to visit for the remainder of the Covid-19 emergency period.
- If the weather is inclement, rain check visits will be established.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for visitors and residents

- No visitation is permitted in resident rooms or care areas at this time
- Face time visits will still be offered.
- Communal dining and hair dresser services remain suspended at this time.
- We have posted on our Website to alert Families, Friends and Responsible Parties to our current conditions and plans to open to visitation. Updates will be posted as needed.
- It is important that visitors properly follow visitation guidelines to ensure a safe visit for their loved ones and to protect other residents and our front-line workers. Visitors that do not adhere to such guidelines will be asked to leave immediately.

We thank you for your continued patience and support during this unprecedented time. The Facility continues to vigorously follow all CDC, CMS and NYSDOH guidelines to protect our residents and their well-being.
